- Hazard information** : Primary Routes of Exposure: Ingestion, skin contact.
- Inhalation** : If ink mist is inhaled, respiratory tract irritation may occur. No known significant effects or critical hazards.
- Skin contact** : Not an irritant. Not a dermal sensitizer. No known significant effects or critical hazards.
- Eye contact** : Not an irritant. No known significant effects or critical hazards.
- Ingestion** : Low acute oral toxicity. Chronic toxicological testing of the ink formulation has not been performed. Based on component characteristics, liver, kidney, and CNS effects are possible if large quantities of ink are ingested.

- Inhalation** : If symptoms, such as shortness of breath or persistent coughing are experienced, remove source of contamination and move individual to fresh air. If symptoms persist, seek medical attention.
- Skin contact** : Wash with soap and water. Should irritation occur, seek medical attention.
